# VOLUNTEERING AT SACRED HEART HOSPITAL PENSACOLA

Interested in volunteering?

At Sacred Heart Hospital, volunteers are an essential part of our healthcare system. Their caring and generous spirits make a difference everyday - one person at a time!

Whether you are a retiree wanting to give back to the community, a student exploring careers, or you just have a desire to help others, each volunteer provides service that enhances the patient and family experience.



## SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Due to the time and cost associated with orientation and record maintenance, we ask that volunteers be willing to commit to serve a minimum of **4 hours per month for a minimum of 6 months, or 50 hours per year.** Hours and days are flexible to fit your lifestyle and training is provided.

## VOLUNTEER CATEGORIES

### ADULTS

Individuals over the age of 18 years may apply to our Adult Volunteer Program.

There are two adult categories

**Friends of Hospital** - this category consists of college students and military or civic organizations who intend to volunteer for a short term or a defined number of hours.

**Mother Seton Guild** - founded in 1949, this group of volunteers consists primarily of those who intend to volunteer for a period of 6 months or longer. Members of the Guild enjoy two luncheons each year and receive recognition for hours and years of service. There are no membership fees.

### TEENS

Students between the ages of 16 - 18 years may apply to our Teen Volunteer Program.

Enrollment in each program is limited.

**Summer Teen Program:** Jun - Aug  
Must be willing to commit to one scheduled four (4) hour shift per week for a total of 32 hours.

**School Year Teen Program:** Oct - May  
Must be willing to commit to one scheduled four (4) hour shift per month for a total of 32 hours.

## VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

How do I become a volunteer?

The first step to becoming a volunteer at Sacred Heart Hospital is to submit an application.

Upon receipt, your application will be reviewed and if you meet all the requirements of our program, including a criminal background check, you will be invited to begin the orientation process.



## DRESS CODE

As you will be part of our health care team, we want our patients and guests to be able to identify you as a volunteer. The only cost associated with becoming a volunteer is the purchase of a uniform from our Gift Shop. Uniform tops range from \$12 - \$22 depending on the style you choose.
